Lion PDG Myron Amstutz, OLERF Trustee Treasurer, reported OLERF is alive and well and allocated the following funds in 2019-20:

The total contributions of the Districts as of May 11, 2020 are \$66,718.78 with one District not reporting to date because they are still collecting their Parade of Checks.

The Foundations Total Assets as of February 1, 2020 are \$2,653,278.40.
